Pedestrian Crossing Signals Down in All Directions at SW Macadam Avenue and SW Nevada Street

Portland Water Bureau crews working on a water line on Southwest Macadam Avenue at Southwest Nevada Street broke an electrical conduit, which operates the pedestrian crosswalk signals.

The Portland Bureau of Transportation is working on the repair, and expects it to be completed by Saturday, Nov. 14.

Pedestrians should use caution when crossing the street with the traffic light.
Motorists should take extra care in watching for pedestrians in these crosswalks.

At the time of the conduit break, Water Bureau crews were working on the Hannah Mason Pump Station project, replacing the aging Fulton Pump Station that provides water service to areas of Southwest Portland.
