

This is to declare that the property listed above is no longer needed for the Portland Water Bureau system and has been declared surplus. Internal studies by engineering and operations have confirmed this decision. They have recommended that the Water Bureau dispose of this property.

This parcel is the site of the first water tank in Portland for the Portland Water Bureau. This site was previously occupied by Portland Parks and Recreation. It will be given back the PWB via an ordinance and is contingent upon council approval. If approved by council for future disposition, the Water Bureau will no longer need this property for any structure or water supply distribution for the citizens of Portland.

I concur with the recommendation to declare this property surplus and dispose of it per the Surplus Disposition and Notification Policy. Your approval to this recommendation is needed. Once you approve, the Portland Water Bureau will notify the City Bureaus and Council offices that this property is surplus and available for acquisition.
