

WHAT'S HAPPENING NOW

Friday, February 1: The Madison Trail reopened! –The trail is open, and several steps and compacted gravel have been added to one section. This allows our crews to continue needed work while keeping the trail open. There will be brief periods when the trail will be closed for deliveries of materials or equipment. Such closures are expected to be infrequent. Please watch for signs.

Beginning Monday, April 2, 2018, SW Sherwood and SW Sacajawea will reopen. The roads will be reopened to vehicle traffic, but some pedestrian paths and parking areas will remain closed. We'll have a new map to share with you by the middle of March.
