

WHAT'S HAPPENING NOW

Today I'm asking for your help with a safety issue.

You all know we've recently made changes to traffic patterns around the construction site. Unfortunately, these changes are not being reflected in GPS apps that people use when driving through the park. Our flaggers have actually had interactions with drivers who insist they can turn the wrong direction onto a road because their GPS app tells them they can.

If you can, please take the following steps to prompt Google Maps to update its directions.

- Visit Google Maps, zoom in on the intersection of [SW Lewis Clark Way and Sacajawea Blvd](#)
- At the top left corner of the screen, Click the Menu icon (the three horizontal lines to the left of the search box)
- In the menu panel, click on "Send feedback" (third option from the bottom)
- Click on Wrong Information
- Click on SW Lewis Clark Way
- Click on it again, then click YES when the pop up screen asks if you want to select the entire street
- Scroll down to Other, click on "Add a note"
- Type in "Shown going the wrong way. Traffic here goes east to west. Traffic pattern changed April 2." You can add something about information causing GPS apps to give wrong driving directions.
- Click Submit
- Click CONTRIBUTE MORE
- Do the same for SW Sherwood, but type the note, "Road open"

Hopefully together we can get these changes made. I'll continue to check every day and send in my feedback.

Speaking of working together, several of you contacted us about the new crosswalk over SW Sacajawea Blvd. and its height or abrupt rise in height, especially from the east approach. Our construction team studied the issue and reduced the angle of the approaches. We even had team members with low slung cars do test drives over the crosswalk. The result is, driving over the crosswalk should be much better now.
