

WHAT'S HAPPENING NOW

The pouring of the first foundation slab is underway and will go into tonight.

The pour got off to a late start, but trucks have now begun to arrive, and concrete is being pumped from two locations (north and south rims of the site) down into the forms.

What to Expect:

- Concrete trucks will be spaced approximately five minutes apart and continue until early afternoon.
- Trucks will enter the site from SW Sacajawea Blvd. through the Madison Trail entrance and from SW Jefferson St. They will offload and exit via SW Sherwood Blvd.
- Expect short delays as trucks are routed onto the site.
- Flaggers will be on hand to ensure the safety of all. Please follow their directions.

Between 85 to 100 trucks will deliver 800 to 1,000 cubic yards of concrete. Trucks will offload their concrete into pumpers that will pump it down to the bottom of the site by hose and into the form. This is the first of 11 foundation slabs that will be poured on this project.
