

## WHAT'S HAPPENING NOW

### Early Morning Work – Monday, April 1 beginning at 4:30 a.m.

The second pour for the reservoir 3 foundation slab will occur Monday. This pour is weather dependent. If weather prohibits work on Monday crews will try again Tuesday, April 2 beginning at 4:30 a.m.

#### What to Expect:

- Crews will begin arriving at 3:30 a.m.
- Concrete trucks will begin arriving about 4:30 a.m. Trucks will be spaced about five minutes apart, and continue until early afternoon
- Trucks will enter the site from SW Sacajawea Blvd. at the Madison Trail, and SW Jefferson St. They will off load and exit via SW Sherwood Blvd.
- Expect short delays
- Flaggers will be on hand to ensure the safety of all. Please follow their directions and traffic signs.

Between 85 to 100 trucks will deliver 800 to 1,000 cubic yards of concrete. Trucks will offload their concrete into pumpers that will pump it down to the bottom of the site by hose and into the form. This is the second of 11-slab foundation pours that will occur on this project.
